<p><b><u>Why Did Jesus Fold the Linen Burial Cloth After His Resurrection?</u></b></p> <p>The Gospel of John (20:7) tells us that the napkin, which was placed over the face of Jesus, was not just thrown aside like the grave clothes. The Bible takes an entire verse to tell us that the napkin was neatly folded, and was placed separate from the grave clothes. Early Sunday morning, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance. She ran and found Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one whom Jesus loved. She said, “They have taken the Lord’s body out of the tomb, and I don’t know where they have put him!” Peter and the other disciples ran to the tomb to see. The other disciple outran Peter and got there first. He stopped and looked in and saw the linen cloth lying there, but he didn’t go in.</p> <p>Then Simon Peter arrived and went inside. He also noticed the linen wrappings lying there, while the cloth had covered Jesus’ head was folded and lying to the side. Was that important? Absolutely! Is it really significant? Yes!</p> <p>This had to do with Hebrew tradition. When the servant set the dinner table for the master, he would make sure that it was exactly the way the master wanted it. The table was furnished and then the servant would wait, just out of sight, until the master had finished eating. If the master was done eating, he would rise from table, wipe his fingers, his mouth, and clean his beard, and would wad up the napkin and toss it on the table. Then the servant knew to clear the table. However, if the master got up from the table, and folded his napkin, and laid it beside his plate, this meant “I’m coming back!</p> <p>He is Coming Back!</p>
