## From the Pastor's Desk:

School is over and summer now begins to get into full swing. In some ways, Memorial Day weekend marks the beginning of summer. But Memorial Day is supposed to be a day to remember those who have given their lives in sacrifice for our nation. Their efforts and sacrifice help ensure that the rest of us can live in the freedom we enjoy, a freedom that can be easy to take for granted. The local VFW will be hosting a prayer service in our cemetery Monday morning at 10:00 am to honor those who have given their lives for us. It will be fairly brief. Please consider taking a little time to come. If you can't do that, then say a prayer of thanksgiving and for the eternal peace of those fallen men and women. Let us commend them to our savior Jesus Christ, who gave his life that all of us may enjoy the freedom of being God's children.

We want to keep you as informed as we can about our plans to add on to our parish hall. With the scurry of the end of the school year, honoring our high school seniors, and a host of other things, I have probably failed somewhat to say everything I intended to. So let me try to correct that a bit now.

I think the price tag of \$780,000 came as a surprise to many. We have tried to hold the cost down as much as possible while still trying to build something that meets the needs of the parish now and in the future. We are still working with the architect to identify ways we can reduce the cost. We've identified about \$35,000 worth of savings and may be able to save even more.

It's important that you know that the \$780,000 includes being fully furnished with kitchen equipment and tables and chairs. Equipment and furnishings are about \$130,000 by themselves. That total also includes the architect's fee of 6% and an assumption of 5% cost overages. Some of the cost also comes from demolition of the wall that is presently the end of building toward the rock parking lot, and the present center wall between the social hall and kitchen. Engineers are also telling us that the roof trusses in the existing part of the building will have to be reinforced. This all adds to the cost as well. If one considers that renovation of part of our existing space is included in the expansion (a total of about 6500 square feet including existing space), then the cost computes to \$120/square foot.

Construction costs have gone up and probably will continue to do so. If you have any questions or concerns, then please ask me or one of the members of the Expansion Committee - Matt Buckman, Linda Baird, Bob Buckman and Paul Cassidy. You can also ask the chair of the Parish Council, Kerry Willett. Please prayerfully consider what you can give between now and next weekend, June 2 - 3, when we will ask you to make a pledge during masses.
